This year, to go one step further with its **green initiative**, Île d'Yeu harbour has acquired a **wastewater pumping station**, located at the entrance to the harbour.



The Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCI) provided this facility with support from the Vendée Départemental Council and the Loire-Bretagne Water Agency.

The pumping station is **self-service**, **available 24/7** and completely **free**.

Your wastewater will be collected and treated. By using this station, you will contribute to preserving the quality of the water in the harbour.

Because of this, at the quay, you will find all the equipment needed to do your part for the **green sailor** initiative!







Wastewater

Use the pumping station (located at the entrance to the harbour) and by doing so, contribute to preserving the quality of the water in the harbour; your wastewater will be collected and treated.

- Greywater (water used for washing), which is full of detergents, limits oxygen exchanges between the air and water. This causes algal bloom, alters the fauna and flora and saturates the environment.
- Blackwater (wastewater from toilets), sometimes discharged close to swimming areas, contains bacteria, viruses and parasites and can cause significant health risks for humans and the surrounding marine environment.
